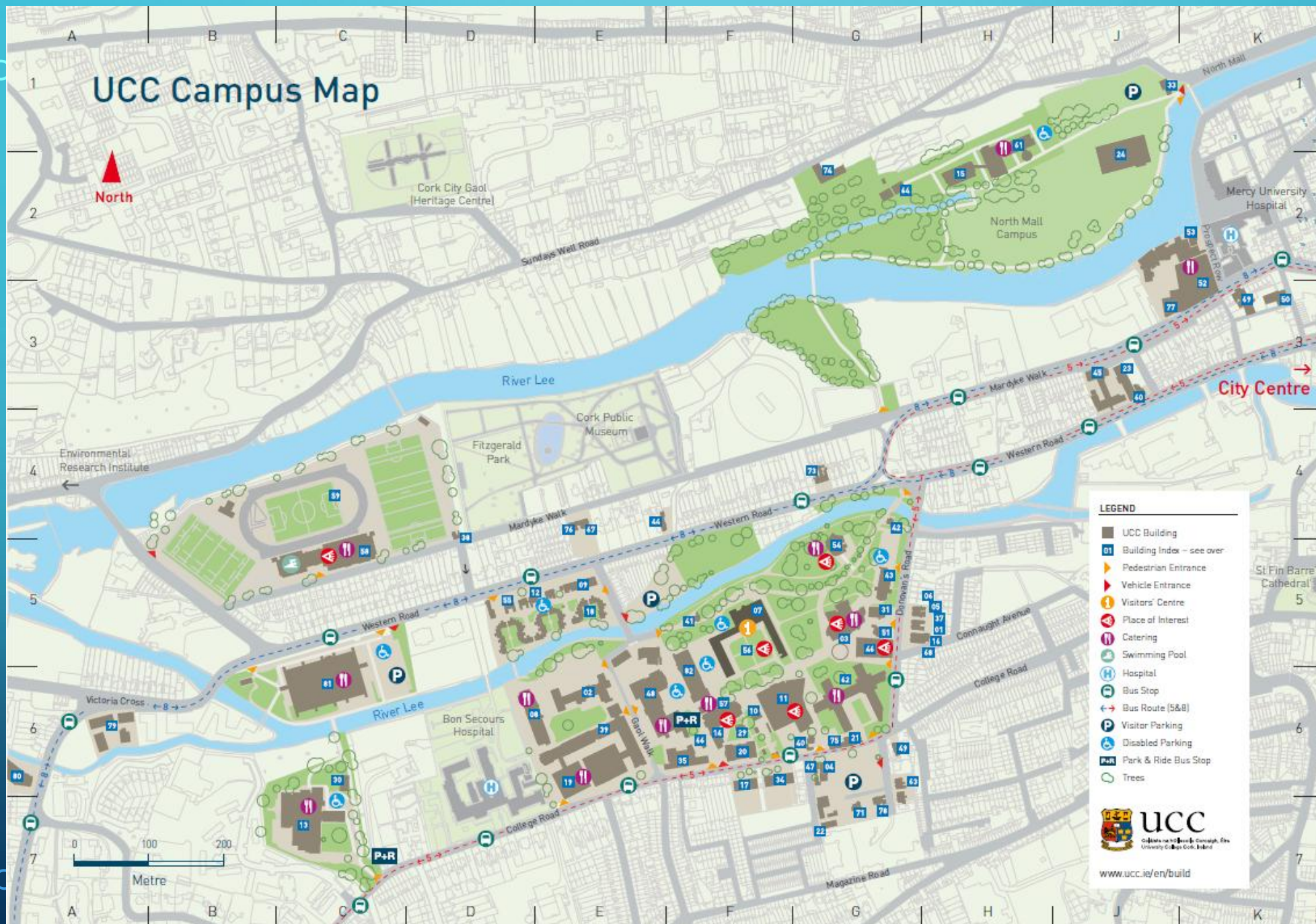

2. - City Hall - Backstage entrance
3. - Tante Cafe
4. - An Cnuisín Lan - Rory Gallagher room - possibly no longer in existence.
5. - City Library - Rory Gallagher Music Library
6. - Capitol Cinema - First Showing of "Irish Tour 74"
7. - Leaders Clothes Store - Origin of the Denims and Check shirts.
8. - Rory Gallagher Place
9. - School of Art - Rory took lessons here.
10. - The Opera House - (and a great concert it was too!)
11. - St. Kierans College where Rory went to school - on this street
12. - Gallaghers - Pub Named after Rory / Plaque to Rory / Crowleys Music Centre - another Irish Tour 74 location.
13. - Tele cabs - Rory lived in this building
14. - Everyman Palace Theater - Rory also played here
15. - Bus Station - Bus to Ballincollig/St. Olivers from here
16. - Location of original Crowleys Music shop - Rory bought his Strat here
17. - Father Mathew - according to Rory the last person he would invite to a party



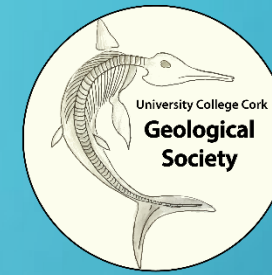
