(\*) A foundation year is open for students, who do not have a legalised foreign high school/bachelor diploma. After the student has legalised the relevant diploma and passed an entrance exam, he/she can be accepted in a subsequent year of studies as a regular student. The results achieved in the foundation year are automatically transferred to the subsequent year of studies (without the necessity of repeating a year).

(\*\*) A regular student has a relevant diploma, legalised by the Prague Municipal Department of Education (high school leaving diploma, A levels) or by the Study Department at the Rectorate of CULS (bachelor or master diploma), and has passed all mandatory entrance exams.




